


HOT OFF THE PRESS - the NEW Miami Beach United website!

Forums and Events

This year we will host Forums on topics ranging from Seal Level Rise and Resiliency, to Candidate Debates in advance of the November elections - our plan is to host a Forum every month. We will also continue our Members' Socials, on a quarterly basis, and will reintroduce a community clean-up volunteer day this spring. Government Affairs

This committee, led by Ron Starkman, is vital to our core mission of advocating for residents. Each month we review the upcoming agendas for Commission Meetings and discuss items that seem to fit within our purview of advocating for quality of life issues. Once the board meets and votes on actions to be taken, the resolutions are written and shared with the elected officials and staff at City Hall. Miami Beach United board directors then attend commission meetings to speak on behalf of the resolutions passed. Ultimately, the year's (November 2018-October 2019) resolutions and legislation will be captured in the annual Commission Scorecard. We would love to have you participate in this process, from tracking legislative items through to representing our positions at City Hall. 
