City Commission Meeting

The agenda for today's "Presentation and Awards" Commission Meeting, May 25th 2022 at 5 p.m., now includes a number of substantive legislative items.

While is is not uncommon to add a couple of minor items to the agenda to these largely ceremonial commission meetings, or, in case of emergency, to add time-sensitive major items, today's agenda includes a number of non-emergent items that are more significant than just "housekeeping." Additionally, at least one Commissioner will not be in attendance.

Because they were added as late as yesterday, we have not had an opportunity to review and opine on any of the issues at this time. However, we thought it was important that residents were informed so that you have the opportunity to read the agenda and any accompanying documents, tune in to hear the discussion of the items, and advocate on your own behalf if so moved.

Of note are:

- Two ordinances (first reading) and one resolution pertaining to the proposed FAR increase for the Alton Road Gateway area.
- Two resolutions (including a public hearing) regarding the naming of the new Alton/6th park.
- Referrals to Committees and/or the Planning Board on issues including proposed
 - street vacations;
 - · height and FAR incentives for redevelopment on Ocean and Collins;



 an upzoned FAR overlay district oceanside between 66th and 68th streets within an existing historic district.
